**Commitment:** The committees would agree to meet monthly, while also agreeing to work on initiatives and communicate with the board, community members, Associa, and relevant professionals between monthly meetings. At least one committee representative is asked to attend the beginning of each monthly board meeting (second Tues. of each month, 6:30 PM). Committee chairs will be offered professional development and other support from the board, while all committee members will be treated to special social event(s) during the year! Committees may create subcommittees/task forces within the committee as they see fit.

#### Lake Committee

Management, problem-solving, short and long-term goal setting for Reynovia Lake, including the lake ecosystem, beach area, geese-management, boat storage, aeration system, and physical structures (e.g. boat house, bridge, deck, retaining wall, steps, dam area, etc.).

#### **GreenScape Committee**

Management, problem-solving, short and long-term goal setting for the trails, wooded areas, common green spaces, and landscaping, while keeping healthy ecosystems, native habitats, and aesthetically-pleasing, pollinator-friendly landscaping goals in mind.

#### Social Committee

To advance a sense of connection and community within our neighborhood. Considers the needs of families with young children to the elderly, and everyone in between. Disseminates community news (e.g. through the creation of a newsletter, creating website and social media posts, etc.). Hosts seasonal events and creates networks of support within the community (e.g. seniors that need snow-shoveling assistance, meal trains for families in need, welcoming new residents, etc.). Sky's the limit!

## Road Safety (ad hoc)

Goal: To increase pedestrian safety throughout the neighborhood through the possible addition of speed bumps, reduced speed signs on secondary roads, and a walking path on Reynovia Dr. The safety improvements could save lives, prevent injuries, and allow children and pedestrians to feel like they are better able to utilize the neighborhood, while increasing property values.

#### Play Area (ad hoc)

Goal: To create a play area for children of all ages in the common green space. The area is full of potential with neighborhood children already using the space daily. Adding play structures will make the space even more inviting. The plan will include features such as a foot bridge over the drainage ditch, improved landscaping, swing set, wooden play fort, picnic tables, soccer goal(s), etc. The improvements will be very enticing to prospective families and will likely increase property values.

#### ARB (established)
